SAE Summer Academy News:

Who: Students who have been invited by their teacher and school.

What: Summer Academy... to keep those brains pumping!

When: Tuesday - Thursday 9am-12:30pm

Where: South Allegheny Middle School

Why: To provide remediation or an opportunity for promotion for students.

Next Steps: Students and parents will be contacted by the Middle School office. An invitation will be mailed and emailed to both the parents and students regarding the Summer program. Parents will then have to respond if their child is attending. Schedules will be created and communicated to the families.

High School Summer Credit Recovery News:

Who: Students who need a meaningful credit recovery experience for those courses that were not successfully completed in the 20/21 school year.

When: Monday thru Thursday 9am-12pm
June 7-24 (3 weeks)

Where: South Allegheny High School

Why: To provide a second chance for high school students to earn up to two (2) required credits for graduation.

Next Steps: Your high school counselor (Mrs. LaRose or Mr. Smith) will be reaching out to you via email and phone call to explain what credit recovery courses you qualify to take this summer. Your counselors will follow that with a registration form for you to apply for up to two (2) courses.
