South Allegheny is committed to providing a quality education for every child in the district. When teachers, parents and community form strong partnerships, all children's potential for academic success as well as their future educational development improve significantly.

South Allegheny parents are provided the following opportunities:

- Participation in an annual Title I planning meeting. Parents will assist in the planning, implementation, and evaluation of the Title I School-wide program. An opportunity to review and revise the parent policies and compacts.
- Open House: Informs parents of events, curriculum, grading system, Special services, teachers' websites.
- Parent/Teacher Conference Days: Meetings to provide parents with information about the academic assessments used and the proficiency level of their student. Parents are informed of ways to monitor their student's progress and how to improve performance.
- On-Line Grade Book: Website that parents can access to view their child's grades, assignments and progress for each subject.
- School Website: Information is posted concerning school activities, programs, and Title I.
- Resource materials for parents. (free to order on website)
- Parent Review and Revise: at the beginning of the school year, parents will review and revise policy and documents through a mailing. The data will be collected and reviewed. Suggestion and unsatisfactory comments will be addressed. Parents attending the annual Title I meeting will review comments and assist in addressing the suggestions and concerns.
- Ensuring Title I parents with limited English proficiency, literacy difficulties, or other disabilities are given the same opportunities as other parents. These opportunities may be structured, adapted or modified so that these parents may receive the same benefits and services as the other Title I parents.
