Pennsylvania American Water's Stream of Learning Scholarship Program was created to provide post-secondary scholarship assistance to students living in the company's service area who plan a course of study critical to the water and wastewater industry.

To apply for a \$1,000 scholarship, students must:

1. Currently live in a household that is served by Pennsylvania American Water.* Note: Students may attend college outside of our service area.
2. Plan to attend a two- or four-year college or technical school.
3. Plan to study environmental science, biology, chemistry or engineering.
4. Complete an application.
5. Write a short essay about their career interests and how they benefit the water or wastewater industries.
6. Include a letter of recommendation from a teacher or community service leader.

7. Include a high school transcript. Applicant's cumulative Quality Point Average at the end of the first semester of the senior year must be 3.0 or greater.
